TO ALL PEACE OFFICERS IN THE COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY:

Proof by affidavit having this day been made before me by Dectective Justin Wireman U/563 a peace officer of Kentucky State Police that there is probable and reasonable cause for the issuance of this Search Warrant as set out in the affidavit attached hereto and made a part hereof as if fully set forth herein; you are commanded to make immediate search of the premises known and numbered as:

659 Arkansas Creek Road
Martin, KY 41649

and more particularly described as follows:

Starting from the Floyd County Courthouse (127 S Lake Drive, Prestonsburg, KY 41653) and traveling through the intersection of Lake Drive and Court Street onto N. Lake Drive, travel approximately 0.3 miles and turn left onto KY-114 W. Travel on KY-114 W for approximately 1.3 miles and turn left onto US-23 South. Travel US-23 South for approximately 5.2 miles and turn right onto KY-1428. Travel along KY-1428 for approximately 3.6 miles and take a slight left onto Arkansas Creek Road and travel for approximately 0.6 miles and the property is on the left. The residence sits on top of a hill just above Arkansas Creek Road. There is an asphalt paved driveway leading to the residence. The residence is a single-story brick house with a sloped roof. The roof appears brown in color and is shingled. There are two (2) roof vents and a roof stack pipe visible from the rear of the residence. Behind the residence is a concrete driveway with a two (2) door garage and a door with a light fixture next to it. The garage doors appear white in color and the door next to the garage doors appears white in color. There is a basketball stand positioned in between the two (2) garage doors. From the back of the residence there is a concrete sidewalk leading around the side of the residence to the front door of the residence. The front entrance to the residence has approximately five (5) concrete steps leading up to the front porch which has an overhang. The overhang appears to be an archway leading to the front door of the residence.

Travel along KY-1428 for approximately 3.6 miles and take a slight left onto Arkansas Creek Road and travel for approximately 0.6 miles and the property is on the left. The residence sits on top of a hill just above Arkansas Creek Road. There is an asphalt paved driveway leading to the residence. The residence is a single-story brick house with a sloped roof. The roof appears brown in color and is shingled. There are two (2) roof vents and a roof stack pipe visible from the rear of the residence. Behind the residence is a concrete driveway with a two (2) door garage and a door with a light fixture next to it. The garage doors appear white in color and the door next to the garage doors appears white in color. There is a basketball stand positioned in between the two (2) garage doors. From the back of the residence there is a concrete sidewalk leading around the side of the residence to the front door of the residence. The front entrance to the residence has approximately five (5) concrete steps leading up to the front porch which has an overhang. The overhang appears to be an archway leading to the front door of the residence.

The property will be forensically examined for the following, but not limited to, any blood, hair, latent fingerprints, deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA), trace evidence, any knives or sharp instruments which could be linked to or associated with

the death of Amber Spradlin. This includes the right to photograph and/or videography of the property for scene documentation purposes which also includes aerial photography with Unmanned Aircraft Systems (UAS) and any land surveying technology systems such as Total Station and GNSS and the right to scan the property. We reserve the right to seize any and all electronic devices (such as cell phones, tablets, computers, hard drives, flash drives) capable of recording or storing data that are discovered on the property which will later be forensically examined by Kentucky State Police personnel at an off-site location. We also reserve the use of blood detection methods including but not limited to, alternative light sources (ALS), and Bluestar in and around the property. The use of a metal detector may also be used to help locate any items of evidentiary value.

and if you find the above-described property or any part thereof you will seize the property and deliver it forthwith to me or any other court in which the offense in respect to which the property or things taken is triable or retain it in your custody subject to order of said court.
